Effective November 1, the new Membership cards will not have an expiry date. This will become your permanent card until your membership type changes, or your card demagnetizes. We will control the validity of membership cards from the back end. You will still be expected to carry your card at the Club.

You will notice your "Member Number" in the spot where expiry date has been removed. Going forward, you will use your member number at the bar. The member numbers are 4 digits or less.

Additionally, we will be launching a new Member Portal, where you can log in and view your transaction and payment history, update your information and receive messages from the Club.

Since 1987, we have been using a DOS based membership system, and it has been good to us! We put the Food & Beverage onto the Jonas system in 2012, but we will be integrating both into the one system in 2018. This will create a more seamless system for members. 
